


PIC18F/PIC16F Quick Programmer bug fix.

Windows 7

On my windows 7 notebook, I found that the text on the bottom line of the MICROCHIP bootloader program, PIC18F/PIC16F Quick Programmer is cropped. This does not affect the operation of the bootloader but it does make it very difficult to read the text.



Before the bug fix.

I have found a fix that seems to cure the problem.

- 1) Right click on desktop,
- 2) Select Personalize,
- 3) Near the bottom of the screen Select Window Color,
- 4) Select Advanced appearance settings,
- 5) Select Border Padding from the Item pull-down menu,
- 6) Reduce the size from 4 to 1,
- 7) Click OK,
- 8) Click Save Settings,
- 9) Windows should have created a new "Unsaved Theme",
- 10) Right click in the "Unsaved Theme", select Save Theme,
- 11) Give the Theme a name. i.e. "Border Padding, was 4, now 1",

This reduces the size of the border around all windows screens.
